Our fees would be between £2,000.00 - 4,000.00 plus VAT and costs payable to other parties ("Disbursements" - see below). Please note that this is only a guide and we would advise you to call us for a detailed estimate specific to the estate that you are dealing with.

Our fees will also be affected if the estate has more than two beneficiaries and if we have to use the more complicated Inheritance Tax forms. We will discuss all these in details once we have a meeting with you.

We would inform you that we do not take a percentage of the gross estate in addition to our fees.

Our fee structure as stated above is based on the following:

- There is a valid Will
- There is no more than one property
- There are no more than 3 bank or building society accounts
- There are no other intangible assets
- There are 1 -3 beneficiaries
- There are no disputes between beneficiaries on the division of assets. If disputes arise this will lead to an increase of costs
- Where there are no trusts in the Will
- Where there are no missing beneficiaries
- There is no Inheritance Tax payable and the executors do not need to submit a full account to HMRC
- There are no claims made against the estate

There are various factors that will affect any Inheritance Tax due on an estate, including the size of the estate and any measures that were put in place by the deceased to limit the tax liability.
